The Wareham Historical Society, Inc. is planning to award a scholarship in the summer/fall of 2024 to a student graduating from Wareham High School in 2024 who will pursue a degree in education. The amount will be determined at the time of the award, but will be up to \$1000.00.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants must have been residents of the town of Wareham for at least two years and must provide documentation with their application to prove residency. Rent receipts, tax statements or voter registration are examples of proof of residency.

Applicants must be 2024 Wareham High School (WHS) graduates from the day program. These students must use this Application for 2024 WHS Graduates.

Applicants must be planning to attend an accredited college granting a two or four year college degree.

All applicants must complete the application and are responsible for seeing that all required documents are forwarded to the Wareham Historical Society Scholarship Committee before the deadline of May 4, 2024. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP:

Students who are awarded the Wareham Historical Society, Inc. Scholarship must be enrolled in a college as described above. The full Scholarship will be paid directly to the college at the end of the first semester only after submission to the Wareham Historical Society Scholarship Committee of an official transcript of the first semester grades, evidence of enrollment for the following semester and proof of continued Wareham residency.

It is the student's responsibility to make sure that college transcripts are received no later than January 18, 2025.
